This is a non-tenure track position. Primary clinical responsibilities will be performed at Regional One Health.

Regional One Health is anchored by highly respected Centers of Excellence in high-risk pregnancy, neonatal intensive care, trauma, and burn. The hospital serves as one of the largest medical and surgical teaching sites for UTHSC and is the primary clinical site for the UTHSC obstetrics and gynecology residency and maternal fetal medicine fellowship.
